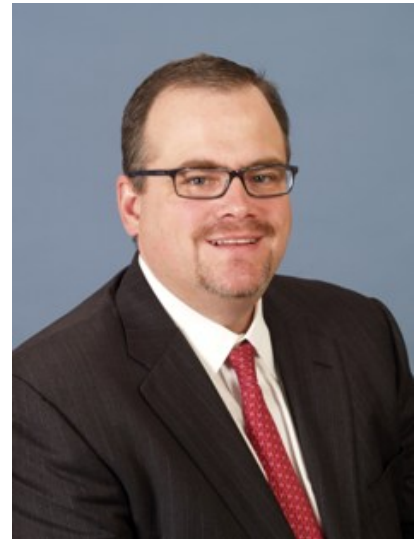
Drew Lapsley, CFA of Goldman Sachs will speak to the group, with a 2013 Market and Economic Outlook.
