Lisa Colleran is President of LifeCell Corporation, which was formed in 1986 to develop and market innovative tissue repair products for the reconstructive, orthopedic and urogynecologic biosurgery markets. The company's mission is to advance the power of regenerative medicine by providing innovative products for tissue repair and replacement that deliver significant clinical and economic benefit. Research is the cornerstone of LifeCell's long-term growth strategy and is funded both by product sales -- this past year, 14% of product sales were invested into research -- and by grants obtained through external organizations, including the National Institutes of Health.

In August 2008, the company was acquired by Kinetic Concepts, Inc. (headquartered in San Antonio, Texas NYSE: KCI) a leading global

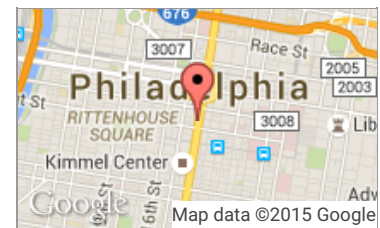
