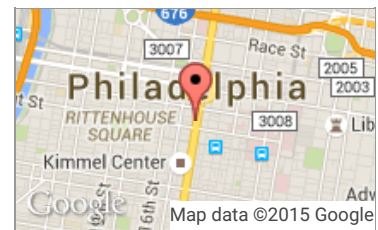

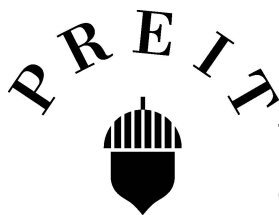

EDWARD A. GLICKMAN is President, Chief Operating Officer and Trustee of Pennsylvania Real Estate Investment Trust, often referred to as PREIT. One of the first equity REIT's in the US, Pennsylvania REIT has its primary investment focus on retail shopping malls and community centers primarily located in the Mid-Atlantic region. PREIT's current investment portfolio consists of about 49 retail mall and center properties.

Prior to joining PREIT, Mr. Glickman was employed by The Rubin Organization, Presidential Realty Corporation and Shearson Lehman Brothers and Smith Barney. Mr. Glickman is also an Adjunct Professor of Finance at the Stern School of Business, New York University, a Fox Chase Cancer Center Board Member, member of the Advisory Board of Jefferson Hospital Kimmel Cancer Center, and member of the Advisory Board for the City of Philadelphia Mural Arts Program.

Mr. Glickman is a graduate of the University of Pennsylvania where he earned a Bachelor of Science in Economics degree from the Wharton School and a Bachelor of Applied Science degree in Bioengineering from the College of Engineering and Applied Science. He also holds a Master of Business Administration degree from the Harvard Graduate School of Business Administration.
